

2021 has been a challenging time at Epiphany. Here are some of the highlights of things we have accomplished together this year:


- The Vestry worked together with the Diocese of Arizona to select our new Interim Rector, Rev. Alison Lee.
- We returned to in-person worship, including social distancing, a reservation system and mask requirements. The Vestry continues to evaluate the COVID-19 situation with safe adjustments to our services, events and meetings at the church.
- We live-streamed our 10:30 church services. Funding has been approved for cameras and microphones that will greatly improve our online worship services.
- We welcomed Brian Grayum to lead our Flagstaff Youth Co-Operative, partnering with Trinity Methodist and The Commons for a strong Youth program.
- We added a security system and fire protection to our historic Epiphany building.
- We continued several Christian education programs via Zoom, including Sacred Ground, our Lenten Series and Education for Ministry.
